Rules of conduct:

All activities in the End of Year plan are mandatory if you attend the subject. If unable to attend due to illness or other very good reason, you must contact the school immediately. The absence will require either a doctor's note or e-mail from parents confirming the absence.

Rules of conduct for EoY examinations:

- Meeting time:
 - **Be there on time!** Check the Meeting time in this schedule. You should be ready by your table at Meeting time.
 - If you are ill or late, call the school: 45 16 82 20. If ill, we will find another day as soon as possible. If late, you will not get extra time.
 - Place bags and coats in the back of the room. Phones must be switched off and put in your bag or on a table at the front of the rooms.
 - Find your table in the exam room – there are small labels with your names and exam numbers on the tables.
 - Bring only your stationary in a see-through bag and a clear bottle of water to the table.
- Reading time:
 - You have 5 minutes of reading time for each paper.
 - You are not allowed to write, highlight, use dictionary or calculator during the reading time, only read and think.
- Writing time:
 - You are not allowed to leave for the 1st hour and the last 15 minutes. If you wish to go to the bathroom in the time in between, you raise your hand and wait for an invigilator. If handing in and leaving the exam entirely, you are not allowed back into the room again.
 - Use a blue or black pen when writing (pencils allowed only for graphs/diagrams; coloured pencils only for Geo; **Pencil + eraser for science Paper 1 - MCQ**)
 - Correction fluid not allowed – cross out anything you do not wish to be marked (outlines, changes, paragraphs). All papers with writing on are handed in.
 - Remember to write your name on each paper you hand in.
 - Write questions numbers in the margin.
 - Remember to bring calculator, rulers etc. if needed!
 - When the exam has ended, you stay quietly in your seats until the invigilators have collected all papers and tell you that you may leave. Do not take any exam papers out of the room.
 - Other rules and guidelines: Ask your teachers!
- **Be quiet – especially when you leave and during breaks! Go outside if weather allows it before talking. There are exams all over the school, also in the classrooms.**
- Bring water for exams and food for breaks!
